Since open enrollment commences on February 18, 2020 there is no guarantee that there will be space available in the classroom for current students who re-enroll after the February 17, 2020 deadline.



Religious Education

In These Days of Lenten Journey

I've been doing a bit of scripture reading lately in order to be ready for my journey through the season of Lent which begins in a couple weeks. Opening the New Testament at random, I found this reading from the Gospel of John: "Jesus said: Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day, and he saw it and was glad.' The Jews therefore said to Him, 'You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?' Jesus said to them, 'Truly I say to you, before Abraham was born, I AM.' Enraged, they picked up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself, and went out of the temple." John 8:56-59

In this segment from the Gospel, Jesus makes an amazing and wonderful claim. He existed before Abraham! They must have looked at Jesus in absolute consternation, their eyes bulging, their mouths falling open at this staggering, audacious claim. Abraham himself bore witness to who Jesus was! That is one of the most remarkable statements in all of Scripture. Jesus uses the name I AM - that is used throughout the Old Testament to describe the ultimate character of God. When Moses was sent down to Egypt to stand before Pharaoh, Moses asked God: "Whom shall I say has sent me?" God's reply was: "Tell the Pharaoh that I AM has sent you." This is the name that Jesus takes to himself here. It cannot be interpreted in any other way than as a unique claim to be one with God. And it was too much for them - they picked up stones and meant to kill Jesus right then and there.



But in that moment of violence and anger - notice what Jesus does next. If it were a Hollywood movie, they might enact this scene by having Jesus leap into the sky like Superman and suddenly disappear into the heavens; or grab a light saber and cut them to pieces like Obi Wan, Luke Skywalker, or Rey does in Star Wars. But Jesus does none of these things. According to the text, he "hid himself." He merely stepped down off a slightly raised platform where he was speaking and disappeared into the crowd and was lost to everyone's sight. Once again, as we have seen all through the Gospel stories, the invisible hand of God is at work, protecting Jesus until His time comes.

As we think about our own personal Lenten journey and what it means, we can take great encouragement from this. When we are walking in the Lord's will, saying what he wants us to say and living as he wants us to live, we, too, are supported by an invisible hand. We need to stay strong in our faith and in God's Words. This is the way Jesus lived in the First Century, and this is the way he invites us to live in this Twenty-First century as well.

So, take some time as Lent approaches to read a little scripture. Just pick up the New Testament and open it to any page and read – and see where God may be leading you.


