Important Notice about Spiritwear -

You may not know this, but we do not actually carry Spiritwear inventory besides a few sweatshirts in some sizes, some of the time. All of our items are custom made when ordered. Our entire Spiritwear process is run by volunteers. When you place an order, it's not like placing an amazon order with 2 day shipping. It takes a little while to get the items ordered, finished and distributed.

NEW THIS YEAR - We will be placing Spiritwear orders once a month on the first Fridays of the month, same as Spiritwear days at school. You can place your order online, any time, but they will be gathered and placed together in one big order with our supplier on First Fridays. You will have your items before the following Spiritwear Day, probably sooner, but guaranteed by the next Spiritwear Day.

We are working on some new designs, but it takes time to get approval and to evaluate sustainability of designs along with keeping the costs down as much as possible. We certainly don't make much money on Spiritwear, especially uniforms which we sell at cost. Everything we do is a service to our community and we hope that you can wear your OLG Spiritwear proudly!

You can place paper orders and I'm getting the new order form up on the school website today that you can print and send in with your payment. Please always label your envelopes as "Spiritwear" and do not send loose cash with your student.
